INSTRUCTIONS & WARNINGS

Thank you for purchasing the Darche Nebula 1550. Before erecting and using your Nebula 1550, please thoroughly read the instructions and warnings below. In order to familiarise yourself with the Nebula 1550, we recommend that you unpack, check that all the parts are included, and set up at home before camping use.

SAFETY WARNINGS



KEEP ALL FLAME AND HEAT SOURCES AWAY FROM THE FABRIC.

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCE SHOULD ANY NAKED FLAME SOURCES OR HEATING DEVICES BE USED INSIDE OR NEAR THE NEBULA.

KEEP CAMP FIRES WELL AWAY FROM THE NEBULA.

KEEP A LOOK OUT FOR ANY AIRBORNE BURNING EMBERS THAT MAY COME INTO CONTACT WITH THE NEBULA.

KEEP A FIRE EXTINGUISHER OR WATER BUCKET NEARBY.


DO NOT SMOKE WITHIN THE NEBULA.

DO NOT OPERATE ANY DEVICE WHICH BURNS FUEL INSIDE OF THE NEBULA.

SET UP INSTRUCTIONS

Select a well drained, clean and level surface. Unroll into your desired position.





- Place the ends of both dome poles A and B into their relevant pin and rings.
- Secure to the ground using a peg in each pin and ring, and four corner leaf peg points.













- Set up the ridge pole C (1 piece) and place one end through the eye in the apex of dome pole A.
- Repeat this process, place the other end of the ridge pole through the eye in the apex of **dome** pole B.








- Starting from the middle top, clip the canvas shell to dome poles A and B.
- Clip the roof to the ridge pole C.



- Insert poles D (2 pieces) into the ends of the **ridge** pole.
- Attach the eyelet at the end of the adjustable awning strap to the end of poles D. Tighten awning straps so the roof is taut.






INSTALLING THE FLY (OPTIONAL)

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The fly can be oriented either way. Position the flysheet over the roof. Connect the two eyelets on the flysheet to the ends of poles D.



Connect the rear and front fly hooks to the canvas loops.



Secure velcro tabs to the **dome** poles A and B.



Set up complete.



CARE INSTRUCTIONS

CANVAS CARE

We recommend that your new Nebula is thoroughly wet down before first use. This will ensure that your Nebula performs well in wet weather by allowing the poly/cotton corespun thread and canvas to swell, ensuring the take up of any potential leaks in the stitching.

CLEANING

Clean with cold fresh clean water and a soft brush.

WARNING: DO NOT USE SOAPS OR DETERGENTS ON THE CANVAS. DO NOT EXPOSE TO PETROLS, OILS OR HARSH CHEMICALS.

STORING

Correct storage is vital. If the Nebula was dismantled when wet, then it and the mattress must be dried as soon as possible.

INCORRECT STORAGE IS NOT COVERED BY THE WARRANTY.

MOISTURE/CONDENSATION

Condensation is a natural occurrence in confined areas like swags/tents due to the body releasing more moisture than the canvas can dispose in cold weather. To minimise the chance of condensation, we recommend slightly opening the window to enable airflow on cold nights.
