




+ MIGHTY 270 AWNING WALL KIT

Instruction Manual



* Vehicle, roof racks, roof bag and awning are not included.

SAFETY WARNINGS

KEEP ALL FLAME AND HEAT SOURCES AWAY FROM THE FABRIC.

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHOULD ANY NAKED FLAME SOURCES BE USED NEAR THE AWNING.

KEEP CAMP FIRES AWAY FROM THE AWNING.

KEEP A LOOK OUT FOR ANY AIRBORNE BURNING EMBERS THAT MAY COME INTO CONTACT WITH THE AWNING AND SIDE WALL.

KEEP A FIRE EXTINGUISHER OR WATER BUCKET NEARBY.

DO NOT OPERATE ANY DEVICE WHICH BURNS FUEL INSIDE THE AWNING.

KEEP EXITS CLEAR.

IT IS RECOMMENDED ALL GUY ROPES ARE FIXED AND TAUGHT WHEN AWNING IS IN USE.

ENSURE CHILDREN ARE SUPERVISED AROUND THE AWNING AT ALL TIMES.


We recommend you check all parts are included prior to first use.

- 16 x Steel peg


+ Set Up


Before setting up, ensure the ground is free from objects. One of the side walls features a door.




Connect the wall to the awning by hook and loop fasteners. Repeat until awning walls are up to your preference. This is recommended as a two person set up.

Anchor the walls to the ground using the pegs supplied.



Cleaning

Clean with cold water and a soft bristle brush. Do not use soap, detergents, bleach or solvents. Do not expose to petrol, diesel, oils or chemicals of any nature.

Storing

Correct storage is vital for the longevity of your awning walls. If on occasion the awning and walls are required to be stowed wet, it is essential it is unpacked and dried as soon as possible. Rot, mildew damage and incorrect storage is not covered under warranty.

Structural Integrity

The Mighty 270 Awning has been designed for general camping use under normal conditions. Always ensure all guy ropes are anchored correctly. It may be necessary to re-adjust guy ropes and pegs at times to maintain the structural integrity of the awning.



ALWAYS PEG DOWN AND SECURE YOUR AWNING AND ENSURE SIDE WALLS SECURED WITH GUY ROPES. IT'S CRUCIAL TO DO THIS ANY TIME YOU HAVE THE AWNING UP TO MINIMIZE THE IMPACT OF UNEXPECTED WIND GUSTS. DO NOT USE IN VERY WINDY OR RAINY WEATHER. WIND AND RAIN CAN DAMAGE THE AWNING AND SIDE WALLS AND MAY ALSO RESULT IN INJURY TO YOU OR OTHERS. PLEASE TAKE A MINUTE TO TAKE DOWN THE AWNING AND SIDE WALLS BEFORE EXTREME WEATHER EVENTS.

Using The Optional Walls

The awning walls will provide a sheltered/protected area around the awning. When attached to the awning, they are designed to create a shaded area and help reduce dust.



THE AWNING AND SIDE WALLS ARE DESIGNED AS A TEMPORARY SHELTER, NOT A PERMANENT STRUCTURE. DO NOT LEAVE UP FOR EXTENDED PERIODS AND DO NOT LEAVE UNATTENDED.
