

Step 1. Press the POWER button to turn the fan on.

Step 2. Press the POWER button speed settings. The fan speed will increase modes. with each press of the **POWER** button.

- Press 2 (2 lights) Medium
- Press 3 (3 lights) High Press 4 (3 lights) - Max

Step 3. Press the POWER button until all fan speed indicator lights turn off. The fan will stop once all indicator lights are off.

Step 1. Ensure unit is switched off and disconnected from a power source before Step 2. Clean with a damp cloth only.


A timer can be set to automatically stop the Step 3. DO NOT use any abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals.
